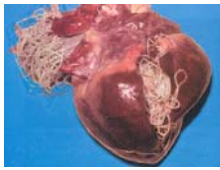




year-round parasite protection for cats

Heartworms

Because of a mosquito that lives in the oak trees at our elevation, Placerville and Auburn have the worst heartworm problem in the western United States. In our area, year-round heartworm protection is urgently important for both dogs and cats. In cats, heartworms do most of their damage in the lungs during the process of growing into adulthood. As cats groom themselves, they continuously recirculate Revolution from the skin to the bloodstream and back again. Heartworm larvae are killed immediately and never have a chance to do damage.



Fleas

By mid summer, most cats have fleas. By grooming themselves and swallowing the fleas, cats often control the problem well enough that their owners don't notice fleas, never get bitten themselves, and aren't aware of the problem. Cats twitching their tails and energetically licking have fleas. Dogs biting at the base of their tails have fleas.



Hookworms and Roundworms

Hookworms and roundworms are an important concern because of their potential to harm people. Children who play outdoors and chew on their fingers afterwards can easily swallow hundreds or thousands of worm eggs. It's a good idea to keep the kids' sandbox covered and deworm family cats and dogs at least once a year. Revolution takes care of this automatically.



Ear Mites

Ticks

Revolution also kills ticks, but not as well as we would like. Cats with persistent tick problems will also need Frontline.
